The following is a list of items that the food pantry always needs: boxed or bagged cereals (10 or 12 oz), boxes of instant or scalloped potatoes, boxed macaroni & cheese, cake mix, canned fruits & vegetables, canned tuna, chicken or salmon, grain crackers, grits (instant), hamburger/tuna helper, jelly, oatmeal (instant), pasta/macaroni, peanut butter, soups, and spaghetti sauce.
