

Share short testimonies about what God has done in your life recently.

Share answers to prayers.

Meditate on a short passage.

Sing songs of praise and worship acappella.

Sing along with a worship CD.

Just listen to a worship song, peruse the lyrics, and/or discuss them.

If you are a musician, perform a song – if you sing, bring lyrics for the group to sing along or just read.

Share a favorite Psalm that focuses on Jesus.

Share a favorite hymn that focuses on Jesus.

Starting with the letter A, continue through the alphabet going around the room and having everyone name something they are thankful for that begins with that letter.

Find a picture of religious significance on the Internet, in a book, etc., such as a picture of Jesus or the cross. Pass around the picture and share different aspects of Christ the picture brings to mind.

Have everyone make a body part (arm, leg, etc.) out of clay or Play-Do and assemble one body from all of the parts. Then ask the group to share how Christ is glorified when we are united as the body. Perhaps the group needs to confess how they can become more like a body. (I Corinthians 12)

Read a very familiar passage of scripture from a new Bible translation and ask what new things were learned about Christ. (e.g., John 3:16 from the Message)

Collect money for someone in need and pray for them.

Agree as a group to pick a day and time to fast and pray for salvation for a friend or family member.

Have everyone think of some commonplace things we take for granted every day and then thank God for them.

Think through the names for God in scripture and discuss the meanings.

Do communion together.

Have the group bring pictures of things they are thankful for.

Meet outside (e.g., take a walk) and praise God for creation.

Share a time when you have seen God's handiwork and it inspired awe (e.g., Grand Canyon, or Niagara Falls).
